Notes

- 1 Hinchingbrooke Health Care NHS Trust ran a deficit in 2013-14. This was covered by £4.8 million in payments from Circle as part of their franchise agreement with the trust.
- 2 London North West Healthcare NHS Trust formed from the merger of North West London Hospitals and Ealing Hospital NHS Trust on 1 October 2015.
- 3 For the mergers of trusts, we have added the demising trusts' income, expenditure and surplus/deficit arising between 1 April 2015 and the date of merger and added it to the income, expenditure and surplus/deficit of the post-transaction trust. This has the effect of treating the merger as if it had occurred on 1 April 2015.
- 4 In our report Sustainability and financial performance of acute hospital trusts, we reported Doncaster and Bassetlaw Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust as having a surplus of £1.6 million in 2014-15. During 2015-16, it emerged that its financial position had been misreported by the trust the corrected year-end position for 2014-15 is a deficit of £14.8 million. This increased the net deficit reported in 2014-15 for trusts to £859 million from £843 million and increased the net deficit for all NHS bodies to £487 million from £471 million. The restated figures for 2014-15 are used in the above table.
- 5 The 2016-17 planned position data is unaudited and taken from analysis and planning completed by NHS Improvement.
- 6 The Department, NHS England and NHS Improvement set aside £2.14 billion for a 2016-17 Sustainability and Transformation Fund, of which £1.8 billion will be used to help trusts sustain services and reduce deficits. Trusts must meet financial targets (control totals) and key access targets in order to access the £1.8 billion of sustainability funding from the Sustainability and Transformation Fund.
- 7 Those trusts marked with an asterisk (*) had not accepted their financial target (control total) at the time the financial reset document was published on 21 July 2016. Sustainability and Transformation Funding has not, therefore, been included in the planned totals for these trusts.
