BRITISH CAR MANUFACTURER ROVER

Thank you for your request of 7 January 2023 in relation to the 'British Car Manufacturer Rover.' You have asked us to handle your request in accordance with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

The specific information you requested states:

"I am after some information regarding the British car manufacturer Rover that went bust in April 2005. Specifically around a car model, I am hoping there are records that have been kept around for a 1995 Rover Metro 114 Cabriolet. Information I am after is how many were produced/sold/price etc.is this information available and if so where could I find it?"

After checking our records, I can confirm that we do not hold any information fitting this description. MG Rover was a private company at the time and was at no point audited by the National Audit Office. You may wish to ask the trade body The Society of Motor Manufacturers and Traders (SMMT) whether they can suggest a possible location for the data you are seeking.

Annex A sets out the steps you may wish to take if you are not satisfied with the way we have handled your request for information under FOIA.
