## The specific information you requested states:

"I require information on the clause which protected TUPE staff from Forward Catering Services to Granada I believe the clause to be called Astra Clause but require this to be confirmed I also require the clause detailed meaning as my I was a member of Forward Catering who transferred in 1995 when Treasury sold Forward Catering Services Since I retired eight years ago my previous employer has failed to recognise any clause or how it protected my terms and conditions of employment."

After checking our records, I can confirm that we do not hold any information fitting this description. You may wish to contact Acas, the Advisory, Conciliation and Arbitration Service. They evaluate workplace services and relationships and may be able to assist you with your request or direct you to the right organisation that can help.
