LOCAL AUDIT CODE & GUIDANCE

Thank you for your request of 18 January 2023 in relation to the Local Audit Code and Guidance. After considering your request, we felt we should deal with it in accordance with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Your specific request states "Please provide information regarding your tender and selection process for choosing auditors used in local authority internal audit. I expect the process to be as corrupt, opaque and inefficient as the rest of the auditing processes within our demographic system. Please also provide details on how to raise complain about a local authority auditor and subsequent audit process."

Having checked our records, I can confirm that we do not hold any information fitting this description. You may wish to look at the Public Sector Audit Appointments website PSAA This organisation is responsible for appointing auditors to local public bodies, including councils, and has published information that might be helpful to you.

I am sorry that we are not able to help you on this occasion.
