Thank you for your request to the National Audit Office (NAO) dated 3 December 2024. You asked for the names of the 29 developers that have signed up to a joint plan under which the government and developers work together to accelerate progress on developer-led cladding remediation.

However, the information you requested has been published by the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government.
