NHS RADIOLOGY LITIGATION CLAIMS

Thank you for your FOI request to the National Audit Office (NAO) dated 13 March 2025. You asked for the following information:

"I have got the overall National figures regarding the increase in radiology claims.

I wanted some details on National figures related to Litigations against Radiology.

- A. Breakdown of the common themes, e.g. missed fractures, missed cancer, etc over last decade.
- B. Breakdown into categories like delay in diagnosis, communication, overcall etc over the last decade.
- C. Most common subspecialty in order, like musculoskeletal, breast, etc"

We have considered your request in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), and I can confirm that we do not hold any of the information you have requested.

The information is not within the scope of our <u>Clinical negligence costs</u> study scheduled for publication in Autumn 2025 or any wider health value for money work we have undertaken. NHS Resolution is the body responsible for claims management on behalf of NHS organisations and may hold the information you are interested in about radiology claims.
